

Start Here

Everything you need to run the World's Smallest Political Quiz with a high school class, on paper or live. Pick a path, copy the handouts it lists, and teach.

1 · PICK A PATH

Every piece stands on its own. Mix lessons, skip slides, or use a single worksheet.

2 · PAPER OR LIVE

Paper. No devices, accounts or setup. Students score their own sheets, and you tally the class by show of hands with heads down. Everything in this kit works on paper.

Live. Apply once for an educator account at quiz.theadvocates.org, then start a session. Students join on their own devices, and the class chart fills in until you reveal it.

Both use the same ten statements, so paper and live results can share one class chart.

FOUR GROUND RULES

- **No names on Quiz results.** Students answer honestly when a result can't be traced to them.
- **The class sees totals only.** Each student's result stays private.
- **No position is ever graded.** Grade the reasoning with T3.
- **Every region is a respectable answer,** and each gets equal time.

5 · COPYING AND CUSTOMIZING

- **Print at actual size (100%)** on US Letter paper, and turn off “fit to page.”
- **Two-sided:** H1 and H5, flipped on the long edge.
- **One-sided:** H6, since each page is used at a different time.
- Black ink and dark lines keep copies of copies sharp. X1 is the only color file.
- **Editable versions** of the lesson plans, worksheets, rubric, letters and slides are in **6 Editable Word and PowerPoint Files**. Change timing, questions and wording to fit your class.
- **Keep the Quiz itself unchanged.** The ten statements, the scoring and the chart only work as written, which is why H1 and H6 are PDF only.

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
